He is an attending psychologist at The Retreat at Sheppard Pratt Hospital and is in private practice of psychotherapy, psychoanalysis, and family/couple's therapy.

April 12, 2019 (Eighth Grade) Kit MacLean, PsyD is a psychologist in Washington, DC. She received her doctorate of psychology from The George Washington University and completed a postdoctoral fellowship at Sheppard Pratt. She is currently in her second year of training at the Washington Baltimore Center for Psychoanalysis and has a private practice in Dupont Circle where she works with adolescents and adults.

April 26, 2019 (The Counselor) Christopher Miller, MD graduated from the University of Maryland/Sheppard Pratt psychiatry residency program in 2012. He is currently an assistant professor in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Maryland School of Medicine, and is one of the associate training directors for residency education, as well as the associate medical director for the Psychiatric Emergency Services.
