Nov 2, 2018 S. Kalman "Kal" Kolansky MD, DLFAPA is a Teaching Analyst at the Washington Baltimore Center for Psychoanalysis and maintains a private practice in Child, Adolescent, and Adult Psychiatry and Psychoanalysis in Alexandria, Virginia. He is Board Certified in Psychiatry and Child Psychiatry, and is Associate Director Psychiatry Residency and Chair Child Training in the General Psychiatry Training Program at Saint Elizabeth's Hospital, Government of the District of Columbia, Department of Behavioral Health. He is Assistant Clinical Professor of Psychiatry, George Washington University School of Medicine. He has won numerous honors and awards, including the Edith Sabshin Teaching Award of the American Psychoanalytic Association and the Irma Bland Teaching Award of the American Psychiatric Association. Over the past 45+ years, he has lectured and written extensively on psychiatry and psychoanalysis including aspects of child development, adoption, child psychiatry, child psychotherapy technique, psychological trauma in children at local and national professional meetings.

December 7, 2018 Robert Winer, MD, is a psychoanalyst at the Washington Baltimore Center for Psychoanalysis, where he is co-chair of the Psychoanalytic Studies Program and chair of the Institute's Curriculum Committee. He is co-author with Kerry Malawista of the newly published "Who's Behind the Couch?" a series of personal interviews with psychoanalysts about their lives and their experience of their work. He has written and presented extensively on film.

February 8, 2019 Lauri Joseph, LCSW-C, ATR-BC, received her undergraduate degree in Fine Arts and Education from Syracuse University in 1958. She received a Masters in Art Therapy from The George Washington University in 1976. Ms. Joseph also received a Masters in Social Work from Virginia Commonwealth University in 1995. She taught art in elementary schools for 15 years; worked in Annacostia with less privileged persons for 3 years and worked for 5 years with persons with chronic pain due to accidents. She has been working for 16 years in a group practice in College Park, with an interest in trauma, chronic pain, domestic violence, sexual abuse, PTSD and grief and loss.

March 8, 2019 Joan A. Turkus, M.D. maintains a consulting and clinical practice in psychiatry and traumatology in McLean, Virginia. She is the Medical Director, TraumaSci: Complex Trauma Disorders Program at Dominion/HC A Hospital in Falls Church, Virginia and Co-Founder/past Medical Director of The Center: Posttraumatic Disorders Program at the Psychiatric Institute of Washington, D.C. Dr. Turkus has years of experience in the trauma field and maintains a national profile with teaching and consultation. She is a Distinguished Life Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association and a Fellow of the International Society for the Study of Trauma and Dissociation, of which she is a Past President. She has been awarded a Lifetime Achievement Award, the Cornelia Wilbur Award for clinical contributions, and a Distinguished Achievement Award by the International Society for the Study of Trauma and Dissociation. She is a Diplomate of both the American Board of Psychiatry and the American Board of Forensic Psychiatry. She is trained in psychiatry, traumatology, clinical hypnosis and EMDR. She maintains a keen interest in neurobiology and psychopharmacology, particularly in their application to the complexity of Posttraumatic Stress Disorder.

April 5, 2019 Julio Smuilowicz, MD, FRCPC, DABPN, is a psychoanalyst in private practice, member and faculty of the Toronto and the Canadian Psychoanalytic Society, member of the IPA whose interest is in the metapsychology of films and who has run a Film programme for the last continuous 36 years.
