**“Dead Child, Dead Mother: Reflections on Paul Gray’s Close Process  
Attention Technique as Exemplified in His Supervision of the  
Treatment of an Adult Replacement Child\*”**

Silvia M.V. Bell, PhD, is a Training and Supervising Analyst at the Baltimore Washington Center for Psychotherapy and Psychoanalysis. Dr. Bell is also Clinical Assistant Professor of Psychiatry, University of Maryland Medical School.

The forum presentation will review Dr. Gray’s supervision of the treatment of an adult replacement child\*. Conflicts around aggression are a central characteristic of the replacement child syndrome. Gray places a major emphasis on manifestations of conflicted aggressive derivatives in the analytic hour. The technique of close process attention will be placed in the context of major alternative theoretical perspectives.

Educational Objectives - After attending this Psychoanalytic Forum, participants will be able to:

1. describe the defining characteristics of close process attention psychoanalytic technique.
2. describe the replacement child syndrome from multiple theoretical perspectives.
3. delineate aspects of therapeutic action in the close process attention treatment of an adult replacement child.
